

Materials List for Foundational

Pilot Parallel Pen 3.8, 4.5 **OR** 6 mm – only one of these is required

(this pen is recommended as it can be pre-filled with ink, eliminating the need to keep loading the nib). However, if you prefer, a William Mitchell nib No. 2, 1.5, or 1 **OR** Brause 2, 2.5 or 3mm will be fine.)

Ink

Walnut ink. I will supply it if you don't have any.

I will lend out **reservoirs** for the ink for the day.

Paper

Any layout pad, preferably A3, but A4 will do. As I originally said that paper would be supplied, that will still be the case, so there's no need to buy a new pad.

Tracing Paper – 2 or 3 sheets. I will have some on hand.

Ruler (for pencil lines)

Pencil - mechanical or medium hard standard (F or HB)

Any favourite words or phrases for writing. I will also provide some for the class.

Water container

Paper towels/ cloth (for wiping nib)

Tea, coffee, sugar, mugs, plates and cutlery are provided
